Reuse Permit M-212-01 – Modification 2

Permittee Name: Dry Creek Sewer Company LLC
Effective Date of this Modification: October 8, 2021

Complete Description of Modification

The purpose of this Minor Modification is to change the Authorized Representative for Reuse Permit No. M-212-01. This Minor Modification also extends the deadline for CA-212-05 by six months to allow the permittee more time to obtain flow and water quality data from Dry Creek during the season in which the creek actually flows through the project area.

Section 2. Facility Information, Page 7 of the Reuse Permit, the text in the second column of the seventh row shall be changed from:

“Responsible Official:

Mr. James Hunter, Manager of Dry Creek Sewer Company LLC; address same as above; (208) 577-5501

Authorized Representative:

Dry Creek Ranch Project Manager; address same as above; (208) 577-5501
(position currently held by Mr. Landon Northey)

Notify DEQ in writing within 30 days if there is a change in the Responsible Official. A minor permit modification will be issued by DEQ to confirm the change.”

to:

“Responsible Official:

Mr. James Hunter, Manager of Dry Creek Sewer Company LLC; address same as above; (208) 577-5501

Authorized Representative:

Dry Creek Ranch Water and Sewer Engineering Manager; address same as above; (208) 618-2147
(position currently held by Ann Dickey)

Notify DEQ in writing within 30 days if there is a change in the Responsible Official. A minor permit modification will be issued by DEQ to confirm the change.”

Section 3. Compliance Activity CA-212-05, Page 10 of the Reuse Permit, the initial text in item number 2 under Alternative Treatment Analysis shall be changed from:

“Within three (3) years of the reuse permit date of issuance...”

to:

“Within three (3) years and six (6) months of the reuse permit date of issuance...”

Modification 2 is hereby approved. This modification to the permit is incorporated into, and constitutes a part of, Reuse Permit No. M-212-01. This permit modification must be attached to the permit. The permit is incomplete and unlawful under IDAPA 58.01.17, *Recycled Water Rules*, without this permit modification attached.
