# Executive Order 2020-01

## Zero Based Regulation (ZBR)

- Followed from Executive Order 2019-02, Red Tape Reduction Act
- Simplify rules
- Reduce regulatory burden
- Provide clarity and ease of use
  - Remove obsolete, outdated, unnecessary language/regulations
- Review rules on a defined schedule

# Common changes

- Replace “shall” with “will”
- Reduce the use of “must”
- Remove redundancies
  - Statute
  - Incorporations
  - Other areas in rules

Published ~August 2023  
- 21 day public comment
