The Idaho Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) is re-forming the **Little Salmon River Watershed Advisory Group (WAG)** to advise the agency on water quality topics. DEQ will initially be working to complete a Five-year Review of the water bodies in the subbasin that are in Category 4a of Idaho's most recent Integrated Report. Five-Year reviews outline appropriateness of beneficial uses, water quality criteria, TMDL targets, pollutant allocations, and other assumptions of the TMDL. The review will describe the current water quality status, pollutant sources, and recent pollution control efforts in the subbasin. The Five-Year review process may also recommend delistings or TMDL revisions to incorporate updated information.

The WAG will assess the appropriateness of:

- Existing TMDL targets
- Pollutant allocations
- Assumptions and analysis
- Use of available data to confirm support data used in existing TMDLs
- Water quality criteria identified in previous assessments consistent with current water quality standards

We hope this group will include a diverse and active membership with representation from stakeholders interested in water quality. For example, we would like to hear from representatives of local governments, private landowners, mining, forest products, land management agencies, agriculture, and recreation interests. The group's meetings will be open to the public and anyone interested is encouraged to participate. Our goal is to ensure meaningful participation from citizens in the watershed and disclosure of analysis and decisions by DEQ.
