Veolia Water Idaho is writing to support the Idaho Department of Environmental Quality's (IDEQ) efforts to change IDAPA 58.01.08, rule 552.01.b.v. back to the language that it was prior to July 1, 2024. We very much appreciate IDEQ's efforts to make this change. The previous language returns the flexibility public water systems have used in managing system pressures and ensuring that property owners receive adequate water service.

Veolia Water Idaho also supports clarifications to the previous language to include specifying that the rule only applies where **customer connections** will see pressures over 100 psi.
