Negotiated Rulemaking Summary

This rulemaking has been initiated to revert the 80 psi maximum distribution system pressure limit to its previous level.

On August 6, 2025, the Notice of Intent to Promulgate Rules – Negotiated Rulemaking was published in the Idaho Administrative Bulletin, and the preliminary draft rule was posted on DEQ’s website. A public meeting was held on August 7, 2025. Stakeholders and members of the public participated by receiving email notifications, attending the meeting, reviewing DEQ’s presentation, and submitting comments. Key information was posted on DEQ’s website and distributed to persons who participated in the negotiated rulemaking.

All comments received during the negotiated rulemaking process were considered by DEQ when making decisions regarding the development of the rule.

At the conclusion of the negotiated rulemaking process, DEQ submitted the draft rule to the Division of Financial Management for review. DEQ formatted the draft for publication as a proposed rule for public comment.
