On August 20, 2001, the Idaho Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) received a Permit by Rule Registration form for a Nonmetallic Mineral Processing Plant from Hagaman, Inc.

Your registration for Permit by Rule is registered in our files. There is no existing air quality permit associated with this company; therefore, no termination action is required. We recommend that you maintain a copy of this letter and a copy of the enclosed registration form for your records.

Please be advised that the registered equipment must comply with the Rules for the Control of Nonmetallic Mineral Processing Plants in accordance with IDAPA 58.01.01.790 through 802 (Rules for the Control of Air Pollution in Idaho). Other Air Quality Requirements

If your crushing plant is portable, you will be required to submit a portable equipment relocation form each time the plant is moved to a new site of operations. This form is required to be submitted to DEQ ten days prior to relocating the equipment. A copy of the form is enclosed for your convenience.
